During April 2023 the Care Inspectorate visited Neighbourhood Networks to review the work we do and speak to our staff, members, and parents and carers.



The Care Inspectorate give care services grades when they inspect them, looking at areas including support and leadership.







Each area is assessed on a scale from 1 to 6, where 1 is unsatisfactory and 6 is excellent.



Neighbourhood Networks received a 6 – excellent – for supporting people's wellbeing.




Neighbourhood Networks received a 5 – very good – for our leadership.

People had been supported to develop skills, secure volunteer roles, employment and education opportunities.



People benefited from a well-run service and a culture of continuous improvement.
