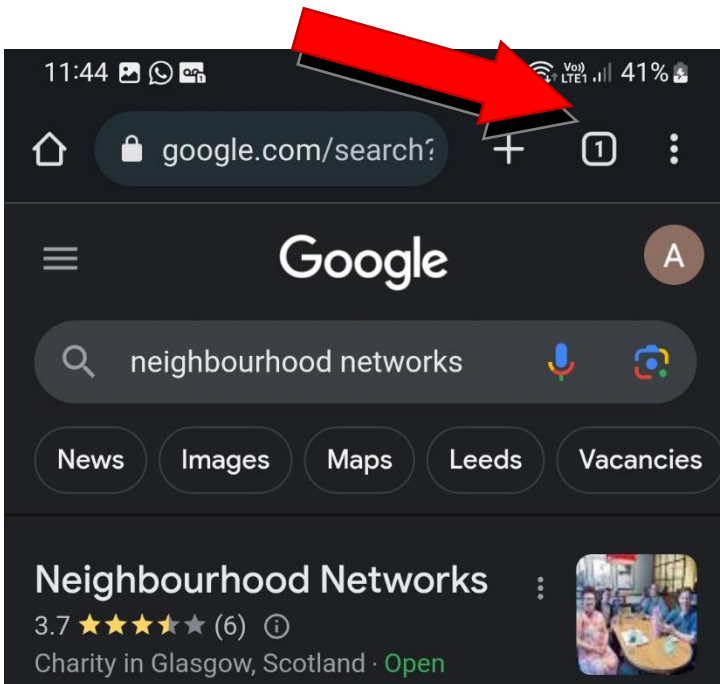
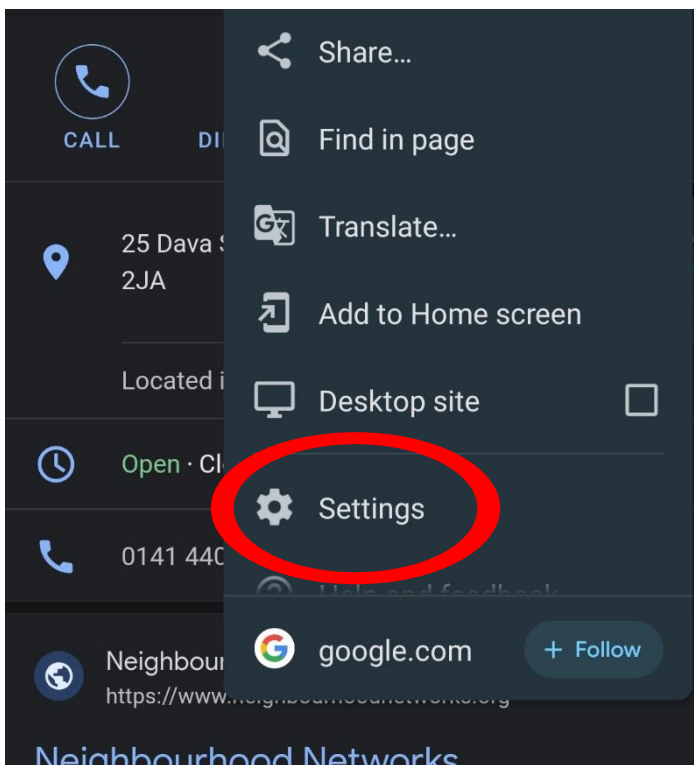


Clearing Your Browsing Data

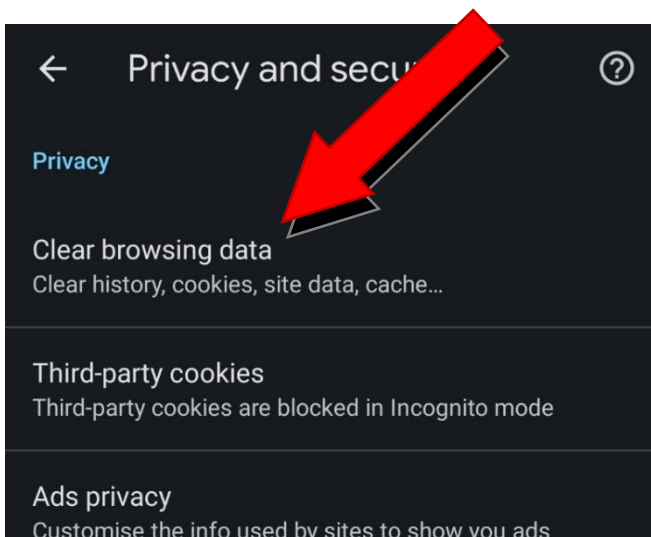
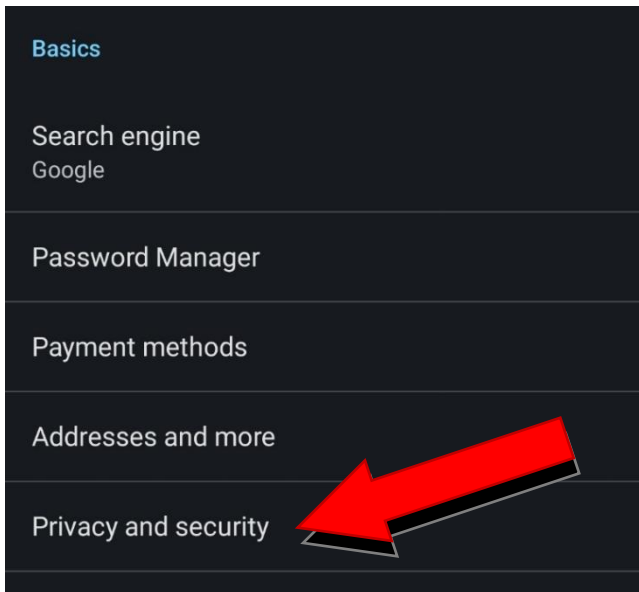


You will then be brought to a new screen. Under the blue header that says **Basics**, you are looking to tap on **Privacy and security**, which is the top right corner. Tap on this option down from the header.

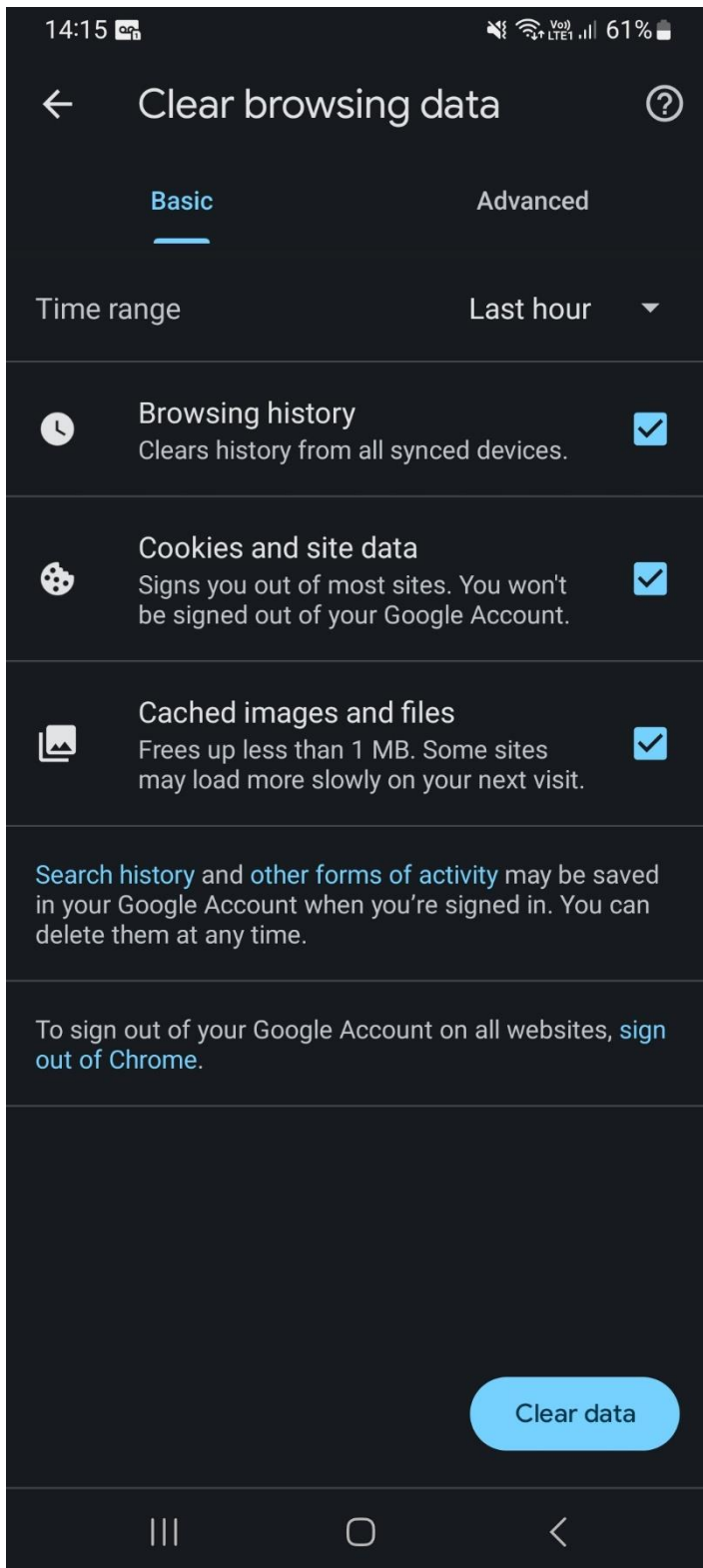
To clear your browsing data and speed up your device, start by opening your browser, and look for the **3 dots** in the top right corner. Tap on this icon to bring up the menu.



Near the bottom of the menu is a **gear icon** that says **Settings**. Tap on this when you find it. You may have to scroll for it if you have a smaller phone.



Under the **blue** header that says **Privacy**, the **first** option is **Clear browsing data**. Tap on this option.



You will get the option to clear your **History**, **Cookies**, and **Cached files**.

Tick what you want to clear with the **boxes on the right**, and then press the blue **Clear data** in the bottom right.

Clearing your **History** will delete the list of past sites that you've visited.

Clearing **Cookies** will sign you out of any website, except your **Google account** that you use on the browser.

Clearing **Files** will free some space, but websites might take a little longer to load.
